DECLARATION OF MATTHEW B. SEARS

I, MATTHEW B. SEARS, pursuant to U.S.C. § 1746, declare as follows

1. I am Director of Operations of Class Action Settlement Services, LLC (“CASS”).

On February 22, 2013, the court approved CASS as Claims Administrator of the settlement in this action. This Declaration summarizes CASS’ role as class action settlement administrator to date and its obligation going forward pending the Court’s final approval of the settlement.

2. In its role as settlement administrator, CASS has done the following:

- Established a post office box for the receipt of claims forms;
- Set up and staffed an information telephone line from March 4, 2013 to the present (whose number was included in the settlement notice and the claims form), staffed by individuals knowledgeable about the settlement and claims process for purposes of communicating with class members;
- Draft summary report on the nature of the calls to the information telephone line;
- Received and maintained documents sent from class members, including exclusion requests, claims forms, and other documents relating to claims administration.


3. To date, CASS has received 56 claims and zero opt-outs. The deadline to file a claim form or opting-out is May 31, 2013.

4. If the Court grants final approval, CASS will also be administering claims for allocation of funds among class members. CASS will evaluate all claims received to determine whether they are reasonable, valid and payable from the settlement fund. CASS will contact a claimant as necessary to confirm the information provided in the claim form, or to seek additional information.

5. Once CASS has completed processing and calculating settlement awards for all timely-filed claims, its final recommendations will be submitted to the Court for approval. If approved, the settlement funds will be divided pro rata among class members whose claims are approved based on their respective purchases of brand and generic Wellbutrin XL.
